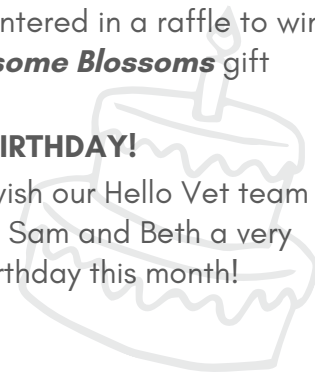

LEARNING ABOUT LEPTO

Please don't let your dog drink standing water

Spring is here and you may find yourself with more opportunities to get out of the house and explore the great outdoors with your favorite adventure buddy! We know how much dogs love water...it's pretty irresistible to splash in and to grab a quick drink. But did you know that standing water, like puddles or ponds, can cause Leptospirosis disease (Lepto)? A dog with Lepto can become extremely sick...it can even be fatal.

What can you do to protect your furry friends?

- Keep fresh water with you so your pup can have a safe drink
- Offer drinks regularly so they're not as tempted by other sources
- Have your pup vaccinated yearly

Lepto can cause symptoms like vomiting, diarrhea, lethargy, refusal to eat and increased thirst. These symptoms may get worse with time. Your vet can check blood work to know for sure if your dog has the disease. There are medications that can treat Lepto, and many dogs will respond quickly once they're treated, but it's important to catch it as early as possible.

Please keep these tips in mind as you are out and about exploring this spring, so your best bud can stay in tip-top shape for adventuring!
